This year's 3G-2L musical is *Greece goes to Pieces!*

Set in Athens around the year 400 BC, this story introduces us to many of the famous scholars in Athens around the time, including Socrates, Plato, Hippocrates, and Aristophanes. Despite its wealth and splendor, Athens is going through a bad time. The Athenians have recently been defeated by the joint Spartan and Persian armies and now have to put up with foreign interferences. The Spartans,

being warriors, are very different in nature to the Athenians and have little time for culture and philosophy, so there is a tension in the streets between the two sides.

Anxious to find out what is in store for their great civilization, Socrates, Plato and Hippocrates set off on an exciting journey to see the great Oracle at Delphi visiting the Olympic games on the way. The Pythia tells them to seek advice from Zeus himself at the great statue in Olympus where they will discover their destiny.



This cast can accommodate up to 28 speaking roles, and additional chorus roles. Roles will be allotted on a first-come first-served basis. Auditions will be held on December 12, with roles being assigned the following day, December 13. Once casting has been determined, a schedule will be sent home with details about what characters will need to attend each practice.

All rehearsal dates are listed on the attached sheets. Please mark any expected absences on these sheets and **return them with your registration form and payment.** **Please note the two weeks leading up to performances is tech week.** These weeks there will be full dress rehearsals every day. Scholars should be prepared to attend every day in full costume.

Additionally, due to winter conferences, rehearsals for Thursday, February 13 and Friday, February 14 have been moved to Tuesday, February 11 and Wednesday, February 12. If you have scheduling conflicts with these changes, please contact Mr. Strand.
