Some students in the club may also have the opportunity to participate in the University of Minnesota's Economics Challenge, where teams of students representing high schools across the state



compete in a series of tests about economic problems, theory, and current events to demonstrate their knowledge and critical-thinking abilities. The Economics Challenge covers microeconomics, macroeconomics, and international economics/current events.

- 2. What is the best way to gauge discretionary spending?
