School Uniform Guidelines

Parnassus Preparatory School scholars are expected to dress in a manner consistent with the school's focus on scholarship, personal character, leadership, and good citizenship. The Uniform Guidelines and Student Dress and Appearance Policy (Board Policy 504) seek to create a safe learning environment, with a unique look for each school that underscores the seriousness of learning at Parnassus and the school's formal culture.

All Parnassus scholars are required to be in proper school uniform during school hours, while on the bus, and during all school activities and events, unless otherwise specified. Attire which creates a material disruption, or which infringes on the rights of others, is not considered to be in the spirit of the Uniform Guidelines and Student Dress and Appearance Policy. Attire is expected to be clean, in good condition, and properly sized to fit. Please account for your child's growth throughout the year when purchasing uniform items to ensure they remain at the appropriate length and fit.

The school crest must be visible at all times. The crest is required on uniform shirts, jumpers, blazers, fleece, and sweaters. For crest embroidery and uniform ordering information, see the guide on the next page.

School of Rhetoric students are required to wear a blazer as part of their daily uniform. For scholars in levels Prima through Fourth Level Logic (4L), scholars may wear a blazer if they wish to do so. Any blazer worn by scholars in the Schools of Grammar and Logic must follow same guidelines as the School of Rhetoric blazer.

Please remember to clearly label all of your child's uniform items with their full name. All uniform items look alike in the lost and found, and items have a much better chance of being recovered if staff can identify the scholar to whom they belong.

Any medical or religious concerns or limitations that might preclude a scholar from meeting the Uniform Guidelines should be addressed with your child's school principal to determine if reasonable accommodations are necessary. All requests for exceptions to the school uniform policy and guidelines must be submitted in writing to the school principal.

The Uniform Guidelines at Parnassus are not meant to be financially prohibitive nor affect any student's ability to attend our school. Families that qualify for Educational Benefits (Free and Reduced Meals) may also request assistance with certain uniform requirements. Requests for financial assistance will be handled confidentially by contacting Ms. Banas at banas@parnassusprep.com.

Parnassus Preparatory School partners with Tommy Hilfiger School Uniforms and Rodriguez Embroidery to offer school uniform items. We recognize that families may choose to order from Tommy Hilfiger School Uniforms or purchase items from another company. Rodriguez Embroidery will embroider the school crest on uniform items from other vendors, including blazers, sweaters, shirts, and fleece items, at their retail store, The 'Sota Shop, as long as the item's color and style conform to the Uniform Guidelines. *Please note:* To ensure color fidelity, all plaid items must be purchased from Tommy Hilfiger School Uniforms. All light blue shirts must be purchased from either Tommy Hilfiger School Uniforms or The 'Sota Shop.

Instructions for Online Ordering from Tommy Hilfiger School Uniforms

Please follow these instructions for placing online orders with Tommy Hilfiger School Uniforms:

1. Go to www.globalschoolwear.com.
2. On the *Find Your School* page, please enter either our Partner School Number (PARN01) or simply enter the name of our school to search for Parnassus.
3. You will be asked for some information about your child, including their grade or school level – School of Grammar, School of Logic, Fourth Level Logic (4L), or School of Rhetoric, as well as their program (Daily Uniform or PE). Once you have selected the right options for your child, click *Shop for this School*. The website will then display the uniform items that meet the requirements for your child's school level.
4. The website will inform you which products require the school crest (referred to as a *logo* on their site), as well as those products for which the crest embroidery is optional.
5. Once you have clicked on a product for purchase, you will be prompted select your color, crest, size, and quantity. The items will be added to your shopping cart, and you will be prompted to either check out or to continue shopping.
6. Tommy Hilfiger School Uniforms has a wide range of sizes for each item, inclusive of many ages, heights, and body types. If you have questions about sizing, click the *Size Chart* link, and follow the instructions. If you still have questions after using the *Size Chart*, please call the toll-free customer service number below. The customer service team will be happy to assist you. You will then be ready to select the correct sizes with confidence.
7. Upon placing your order, you will receive an email confirming that your order has been received. Once your order has shipped, you will receive an email confirming shipping date and tracking information.
8. Your order history will be stored in your account, and you can come back to the website anytime to place additional orders.

For all customer service questions, please call 1-800-217-7761. Customer service representatives are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Customer service is available in both English and Spanish.

Rodriguez Embroidery/The 'Sota Shop Information

Parnassus partners with Rodriguez Embroidery, a locally owned and operated business, to embroider our school crest on uniform items purchased from vendors other than Tommy Hilfiger School Uniforms, so long as those items are approved as a substitution.

The cost of adding the school crest to a blazer, shirt, sweater, fleece, or vest will be \$10.00 per item.

Please note that The 'Sota Shop will **not** embroider light blue oxford or polo shirts from other vendors; however, they will embroider white shirts, navy blazers, sweaters, vest, and fleeces from any vendor so long those items conform to the Uniform Guidelines. The 'Sota Shop has a copy of the Uniform Guidelines available at their store.

Parnassus Preparatory School Dress Code for Non-Uniform Events

“Non-Uniform Events” include, but are not limited to, school-sponsored social events such as fun nights, movie nights, dances, etc. The School of Rhetoric Formal has a separate dress code, which will be provided to students in advance of the event each spring.

We take pride in the appearance of our students at all school-sponsored events and activities. How one acts is often affected by one’s attire, which is a guiding premise for student uniforms during the instructional day as well as at school events. Students are expected to dress appropriately in clean, well-fitting clothing that is appropriate for the weather and the occasion. Students dress or attire must adhere to the following *minimum* standards, which align with the school’s Student Dress and Appearance Policy:

- Students may not wear scanty or revealing clothing. Examples of these items include **but are not limited to** tube tops, halter tops, backless tops, strapless tops, spaghetti straps, and clothing that exposes the midriff and/or undergarments.
- Students must wear shoes/appropriate footwear at all times.
- No garments that advertise alcohol, alcohol establishments, tobacco products, or other drugs may be worn.
- No attire with messages or symbols that include profanity, violent or sexual language/actions, or inappropriate subject matter is allowed.
- Any attire or accessory which, by its design, use, or intended use could cause bodily harm, property damage, or intimidation to other persons, may not be worn. Examples of these items include, **but are not limited to**, chains, leather straps, pet collars, and spikes.
- No attire with any gang-related purpose is allowed.
- Body markings or tattoos must be fully covered at all times.

The above list is not meant to be exhaustive; rather, it is intended to provide some idea of acceptable dress. Since styles of clothing change rapidly, the administration reserves the right to restrict certain fashions that are inappropriate, as well as interpret what is considered to be in poor taste or distracting to the school-sponsored activity.

Music Performance Dress Code

- Must be regular school uniforms
- No special dress required

Dress Code for Extracurriculars and Activities

When participating in a school-sponsored extracurricular activity, students are generally expected to wear their Parnassus uniforms. For athletic activities where the normal school uniform would impede required physical activity – such as Running Club or Fencing, for example – the school has issued the following dress code.

Students are expected to dress appropriately in clean, well-fitting clothing that is appropriate for the weather and the occasion. Students dress or attire must adhere to the following *minimum* standards. The standards maintained align with the school's dress code policy.

- Undergarments must not be visible
- Students must wear shoes/appropriate footwear at all times.
- No garments that advertise alcohol, alcohol establishments, tobacco products, or other drugs may be worn.
- No attire with messages or symbols that include profanity, violent or sexual language/actions, or inappropriate subject matter is allowed.
- Any attire or accessory which, by its design, use, or intended use could cause bodily harm, property damage, or intimidation to other persons, may not be worn. Examples of these items include, **but are not limited to**, chains, leather straps, pet collars, and spikes.
- No attire with any gang-related purpose is allowed.
- Body markings or tattoos must be fully covered at all times.

The above list is not meant to be exhaustive; rather, it is intended to provide some idea of acceptable dress. Since styles of clothing change rapidly, the administration reserves the right to restrict certain fashions that are inappropriate as well as interpret what is considered to be in poor taste or distracting to the school-sponsored activity.

School of Rhetoric Toga Day Dress Code

- All students participating in the dress-up day must wear their regular uniforms under their togas. They may remove their blazers, which should be kept in their lockers during the day.
- Togas must be solid colors only. No prints or writing.
- Togas should be worn in the style of classical orators from ancient times – solid color sashes are allowed.
- Toga choice must be school appropriate and academic in nature.
- Our focus will remain on teaching and learning. Please ensure that togas do not impede normal movement.
- Weapons, real or fake, are not allowed.
- Students who do not wish to participate in the dress-up day should plan to wear their school uniforms in accordance with the normal school uniform policy.
