

Teams of up to five School of Logic scholars will compete in a bee style competition to achieve science glory! The season will culminate at the Minnesota Regional Science Bowl competition which is typically held in mid-February. The competition uses a buzzer system and is played against teams from other schools across the Twin Cities.
