

New and returning students are invited! Join this fast-growing Olympic sport taught by Parnassus' own Magister Smith! Magister Smith has a strong competitive background in fencing, most recently coaching at a school in Idaho. He also trained for several years with a former Olympic-qualifying fencer.



Students will start with basic fencing skills and learn new moves and concepts each week. They will pair up to practice their newly learned skills and spend the last portion of each class fencing against other athletes at the same skill level.

All fencing equipment will be provided, but we ask that all scholars bring non-scuffing closed-toed shoes, comfortable athletic clothes, and bring a water bottle to every practice.

Due to high demand in previous sessions, the maximum enrollment for this activity is 10, with a waitlist for additional scholars who may be added based on equipment availability.
